FROM THE PASTOR

The Lord be with you all!

And happy New Year!

It's always difficult for the church to get "business" done from Thanksgiving through New Year's Day. That means that January is usually a very busy month. That's certainly true for our spiritual village!

On the last Sunday of the month, January 29th, we will be gathering for our congregation's **annual meeting** following the 10:00 AM worship service. At this meeting, the main item of business will be the approval of a budget for the congregation's ministry and mission in 2017.

Late this fall, our Council formally recommended the adoption of a \$490,000 budget. Over the coming weeks, the Council will formally present the details of that budget during temple talks in worship. We've found this approach to be helpful for a few reasons. First, it gives the congregation time to consider the details of the proposed budget and ask any questions we may have. Second, it embodies our ministry's commitment to financial transparency. And finally, it usually helps to make the annual meeting itself run as smoothly as possible.

In addition to preparing ourselves for the annual meeting, we will also formally resume our conversation about the long-term stewardship of our facility and property. If you remember, the Council presented us with our **three basic facility/property options** just before Thanksgiving. They are as follows: (1) invest about \$1 million in our current facility, (2) raise about \$2 million to replace our facility with a new facility on our property, or (3) sell our facility and property in order to relocate and build new.

During the month of January, there will be **opportunities to gather** for further conversation about these options. Please pray for our congregation, that our gracious God would grant us wisdom in these conversations! And when the dates and times of these gatherings are announced in early January, please make attending at least one of them a high priority.

God bless you all for your partnership in Christ's gospel! Ryan+

funded by private donations and is the only free mobile primary care clinic in Maricopa County. <u>Three dollars of every coffee purchase will help to provide glucose test strips for diabetic patients (an essential need to help them manage their disease)</u> – normally an out-of-pocket cost of \$100 per month. Through your coffee purchases, you will be supporting <u>TWO</u> ministries for the price of one! Check out the Fair Trade coffee display at the back of the sanctuary. Also available by order, with the same global and local impact: baking cocoa, Fair Trade Equal Exchange chocolate and all occasion artisan gift items.


Collect items from home, businesses, family, and friends and bring them in to the church office. Help teach our children how to become a hero and **Reduce**, **Reuse and Recycle**.
